

#### **Project Location**

In Wrightwood, on State Route 2 at Sheep Creek Bridge (No. 54-360), in San Bernardino County at post mile 2.44.



#### **Purpose & Need**

The purpose of this project is to address the recommendation from the Maintenance and Investigations (SM&I) Structure Replacement and Improvement Needs (STRAIN) Report to upgrade the existing bridge railing. In addition, the project will install guardrail sidings, widen the bridge on both sides, and incorporate standard shoulders.

#### **Bridge Features**

#### Q: Will a pedestrian path be added to the bridge?

A: No. A pedestrian bridge will not be added to the project widening design. The additional environmental studies and cost would delay the overall project delivery schedule.

#### Q: Will lighting be added to the bridge?

A: No. Overhead lighting will not be added to the bridge. However, reflective pavement markers will be installed.

#### Q: Will traffic be detoured into the local community?

A: No. Non local traffic will be detoured to State Route18, Bobs Gap Rd, and Big Pines Hwy.

#### **During Construction**

## Q: Will local traffic be allowed to use Wright Mountain Rd?

A: Yes. During full closures, locals will be allowed to use Wright Mountain Rd to access Wrightwood.

#### Q: How long will the project be in construction?

A: Construction activities are expected to last two years.

A: No. Construction activities will be in suspension during the winter seasons.
