## HOLLYWOOD FREEWAY (US 101) CLOSURES

**LOS ANGELES** - The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will close portions of the Hollywood Freeway (US 101) between Los Angeles Street and Highland Avenue as part of a pavement rehabilitation project. The following schedule will be in effect.

### Northbound US 101

#### **Friday Night, September 26**

- 11.59 p.m. to 6 a.m. – Up to three lanes between Alameda St. and Grand Avenue
- 10 p.m. to 9 a.m. – North- and southbound connectors to I-110

#### **Saturday Night, September 27**

- 2 a.m. to 5 a.m. – Up to three lanes between Alameda St. and Grand Avenue
- 10 p.m. to 9 a.m. – North- and southbound connectors to I-110

#### **Sunday Morning, September 28**

- 2 a.m. to 9 a.m. – Up to three lanes between Alameda St., and Grand Avenue

### Southbound US 101

#### **Saturday Morning, September 27**

- 1 a.m. to 6 a.m. – Up to three lanes between Highland Avenue and Sunset Boulevard

#### **Sunday Morning, September 28**

- 2 a.m. to 9 a.m. – Up to three lanes between Cahuenga Boulevard and Gower Street

All American Asphalt is the contractor on this \$500,000 project which will extend the life of the freeway, provide a smoother driving surface and a safer commute. Estimated completion is late winter 2008. Caltrans advises motorists to “**Slow For The Cone Zone.**”
