FULL CLOSURE OF INTERSTATE 5 AT CAMINO DE ESTRELLA

Irvine— The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will intermittently close Interstate 5 at Camino De Estrella for bridge work

Friday November 30th – Saturday December 1st, 2012

10 p.m. to 6 a.m. Surface Street Eastbound and Westbound Camino De Estrella #1 lane.

11 p.m. to 7 a.m. Northbound I-5 at Camino De Estrella 11 p.m. to 7 a.m. Lane #1. 12 midnight to 6 a.m. Lane #1 & 2. closure.

12 midnight to 7 a.m. Southbound I-5 at Camino De Estrella 12 a.m. to 7 a.m. Lane #4, 3. 12 midnight to 6 a.m. Lane #4,3,2. **1 a.m. to 5 a.m. FULL Mainline Closure.**

Detour: I-5 Southbound Off ramp at Camino De Estrella and back on I-5 Southbound On Ramp.

Saturday December 1st - December 2nd, 2012

10 p.m. to 6 a.m. Surface Street Eastbound and Westbound Camino De Estrella #1 lane.

11 p.m. to 7 a.m. Southbound I-5 at Camino De Estrella 11 p.m. to 7 a.m. Lane #1. 12 midnight to 6 a.m. Lane #1 & 2. closure.

12 midnight to 7 a.m. **Northbound I-5 at Camino De Estrella** 12 midnight to 7 a.m. Lane #4, 3. 12 midnight to 6 a.m. Lane #4,3,2. **1 a.m. to 5 a.m. FULL Mainline Closure.**

Detour: I-5 Northbound Off Ramp at Camino De Estrella and back on I-5 Northbound On Ramp.
