



This means that a fax machine was connected and the first page was transmitted, but the system lost the connection. It did not get a response from the remote fax machine saying that it had received the page. It must be assumed that the page was not received.

Fax Status Legend

KeyesFax

No connection or Did not connect

This means that the first page was not even attempted. A fax machine did answer the phone but the 2 systems could not establish a connection

Phone Rang, Ringing

While the fax was getting ready to be sent, the phone rang.

May not be Class 1 Fax modem

This is caused when the fax system asks the modem what class it is and the modem does not respond correctly. The system issues this message, then Varies OFF the Fax line and Varies it back ON. This usually resets the modem so that it again works properly. If the modem was not a Class 1 modem or if it were malfunctioning, you would get this message 6 times then the system will shut the fax line down.

Modem not responding

This is similar to the above explanation.

No Confirmation, Not Cnfrmd

At the end of each page a fax machine is supposed to confirm that it has received the page. Sometimes this confirmation is lost, due to an incompatibility with the modem that you are using. In this case, we do not resend the same page. To do so would usually result in the same page being sent, repeatedly.

, will retry

When this is added to a message it means that the job has been scheduled to try again in a few minutes.

, Job canceled

When this is added to a message it means that the system cannot complete the fax and it is going to stop trying, usually because it has exhausted all of the retries.

, Resubmitting

When this is added to a message it means that the system is automaticall resubmitting the job to try to correct the problem.
