<sup>1</sup>Cargo Service Airport - An airport that is served by all-cargo aircraft in scheduled and nonscheduled service providing air transportation of only property, including mail, with an aggregate landed weight in excess of 100-million pounds. Reporting airports may be eligible to FAA AIP cargo entitlement funds. However, the State of California has expanded this report to include airports that do not meet the FAA criteria for a Cargo Service Airport designation. To easily identify which of the airports listed are not designated as a Cargo Service Airport we have included an asterisk following the airport name. The list will include other airports as they are identified as providing air cargo service utilizing any size aircraft, and the Division will include them as long as they report cargo activity.
